I'd like to focus our thoughts this month on being a good Dad, a Knight Dad. What does being a Knight Dad mean? I'm not going to pretend to be an example of one, but I would like to share with you ancient wisdom for modern Dads by Father Dwight Longnecker in his Knights of Columbus booklet Saint Benedict for Busy Parents.

How does a Knight Dad run a modern household? The Knight Dad is the loving head of the home. One of the most important parts of this is humility, the cornerstone for all who follow Christ. This is the foundation for the way the father rules the home. All this is done in humility and with the spirit of service to all.

Look to the Father in heaven as the model for merciful leadership. That Father is pictured in the story of the Prodigal Son. The Knight Dad should grow spiritually and as he grows closer to God, become that loving Father in the home who pictures for his children the love of the heavenly Father. Fatherhood in the home is an awesome and daunting task. It takes a real man to live up to it.

The Knights of Columbus has a Building the Domestic Church program. How can parents make their home a domestic church? The Benedictine Rule is built around three vows and three tools. The vows are Obedience, Stability and Conversion of Life. The tools are Work, Prayer and Study. A further exploration of these rules takes us more deeply into the profound wisdom of St. Benedict today.

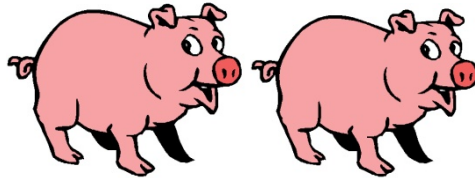
Looking for a way to give back to our school and Church?

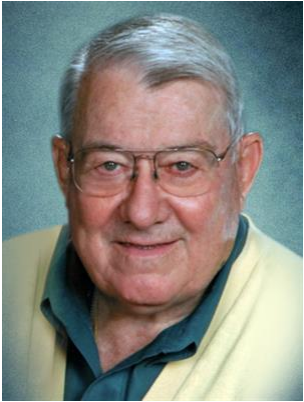

Chuck Richardson

We were sad to hear of the passing of Brother Chuck Richardson who passed away on June 30th.



Chuck attended Iowa State Teachers College and received his Masters from Indiana University. In 1955 he joined the faculty at Columbus High School where he would serve the next 35 years as a teacher, dean and athletic trainer for thousands of students. He arguably taught half of Bartholomew County how to drive.

To say Chuck did everything would be an understatement. He was a teacher, coach, athletic trainer, BCSC board Member, licensed pilot, director of the local Fellowship of Christian Athletes, ran countless church youth groups, Scoutmaster, shortwave radio operator, Eucharistic Minister and served in the military.

He joined the Army on his 18th birthday and served with the Occupational Forces in Japan as WW II ended. Back home he served as a paratrooper with the Iowa and Indiana National Guards, then with the Air Force Reserve as an intelligence officer in various Special Operations groups. When he retired as a Lieutenant Colonel, he was the highest ranking US Air Force officer on jump status.

Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated at St. Bartholomew Church with Father Clem as celebrant on July 9th.

Chuck was buried with full military rites presented by the US Air Force Ceremonial Unit and the Bartholomew County Veterans Honor Guard with burial at Garland Brook Cemetery.

Chuck's greatest joy laid in being a help and friend to everyone he met. He would have you remember this: No man is a failure who has friends.

Chuck supported many Knight of Columbus activities, especially the golf outings. A donation to Gibault is being made in his name from our council.
